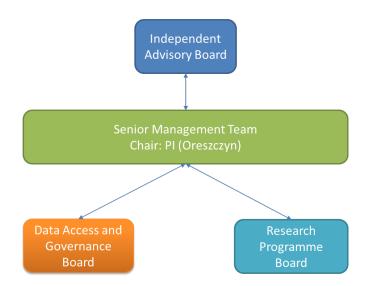


Summary of SERL Management Structure



The overall responsibility for leadership of SERL rests with the Principal Investigator (Professor Tadj Oreszczyn, UCL). He is the chair of a **Senior Management Team (SMT)** who jointly provide operational and strategic management of the project. The SMT provide a progress report to the Independent Advisory Board (IAB) and the SERL Consortium every 3 months.

The **Independent Advisory Board (IAB)** will provide strategic oversight and guidance to the SERL Senior Management Team. Its remit is to make sure SERL provides maximum benefit to the research community, while minimising external risks. The IAB has no responsibility for delivery of the SERL work programme.

The **Data Governance Board (DGB)** will be the independent decision-making authority regarding approval for each research project that requests access to SERL data by applying a set of transparent criteria that reflect SERL's robust data governance protocols.

The **Research Programme Board (RPB)** will oversee the co-creation and prioritisation of the SERL research programme and advise on the Pathways to Impact of SERL research. **NB**. The RPB only applies to SERL-funded research projects. The RPB will have no role in approving research projects that use the SERL portal but are conducted by non-SERL researchers.
